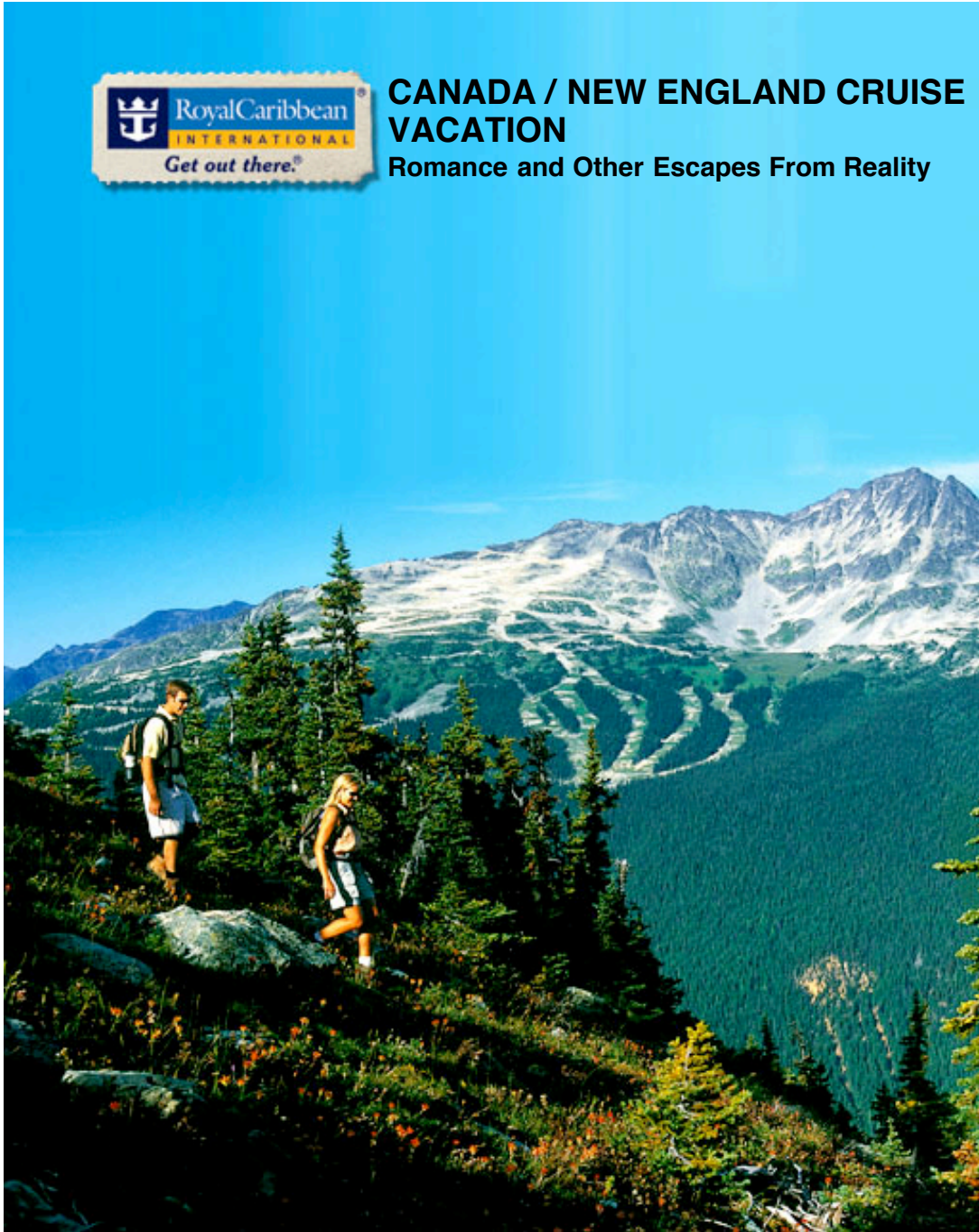

### CAPE LIBERTY, BAYONNE, N.J.
